- She came to our programs and shared with us about the books she loved- and the books she didn't. She loved to travel and to garden-- both interests we were lucky to learn about through her. On one of her travels, she visited Scotland then returned with lovely book marks for each of us.
- During the year, she came with her husband twice a week -- both of them avid readers. Each summer, we would look forward to seeing her grandchildren. They made the library summer reading program a part of their annual summer family visit. Her generous spirit was always expressed-- through prayers, kind words, and gifts.
- He became connected to the library through his wife, an avid reader. They raised their children here and were frequent library visitors. After she passed, he continued to remember the library at Christmas with calendars and cookies.
- Several times a week, he would visit the library to get books and chat. When he reached 3000 books, we gave him an honorary gold star. He went on to surpass 4000. Another passion was painting ceramics. He generously shared his art and his love of reading with us.
