- Register at the library beginning Monday, May 20.

Pick up your reading activity log when you register in the library.

No matter how you track your reading, here's how it works:

Earn prizes for completing reading and related activities

- Every time you complete an activity from the reading activities log, you get one entry into the grand prize drawing for your age group (up to 15 entries per summer reading participant).
- For every 5 activities you complete on the Reading Activities log, select a prize from the prize cart for your age group or a book from the book sale.
- Registration begins May 20, but you may count any reading done between May 1 and July 18.
