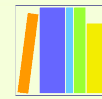

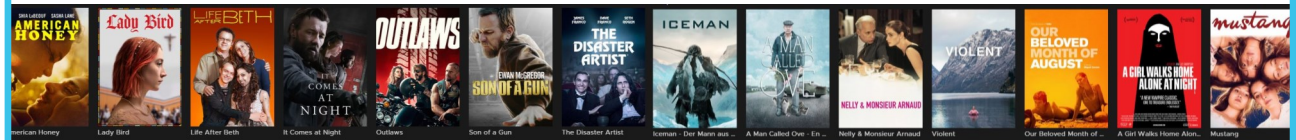
## Magazines
